# **Terms of Use Agreement**

## **Acceptance of Terms**

The Center for Advanced Studies in Child Welfare (hereafter "CASCW") is a center located in the School of Social Work, College of Education & Human Development, University of Minnesota. Access to CASCW's Child Welfare Video Wall ("CASCW Video Wall") is subject to the following Terms of Use ("TOU"), which may be revised or updated by CASCW at any time. We will provide notice through our website if changes should occur (http://z.umn.edu/L4T). You can review the current version of the TOU at this location at any time.

By clicking below, you are agreeing that you are 13 years of age or older or have a parent/guardian present with you at the time of the recording.

## **Purpose**

In accordance with CASCW's mission, which is to improve the quality of public child welfare in order to improve the lives of children and families involved in child welfare, the purpose of the CASCW Video Wall is to promote a national dialogue on issues related to the field of child welfare in order to improve outcomes for children and families involved in child welfare.

### **User Conduct**

CASCW reserves the right to review videos submitted by Users ("User Content") prior to posting them to the CASCW Video Wall. Videos submitted by Users must be original and must not infringe on the intellectual property rights of others. In addition, CASCW expects that users will treat each other, as well as CASCW staff, with respect. CASCW may opt to not post User Content that contains vulgar or abusive language; personal attacks of any kind; offensive terms that target specific people or groups; or that is unlawful, defamatory, obscene, invasive of another's privacy, or otherwise deemed objectionable or offensive by CASCW staff in its sole discretion. User Content must not incite or encourage violence. CASCW may also remove User Content that is spam, is "off topic" (i.e. not related to child welfare or the question being answered on the CASCW Video Wall), or that promotes services or products.

### **Indemnity**

You agree to indemnify and hold CASCW, and its officers, employees, independent contractors, agents, representatives, affiliates, and other partners, harmless from any claim, demand, action, damages, losses, or costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, made by any third party in connection with, related to, or arising out of any User Content that you submit to the CASCW Video Wall, your use of the CASCW Video Wall, your connection to the CASCW Video Wall, your violation of the TOU, or your infringement upon or violation of any copyright, trademark, or other intellectual property rights of another.

### **Modifications to Service**

CASCW reserves the right to, at any time, modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, the CASCW Video Wall (or any part or Content thereof). You agree that CASCW shall not be



liable to you or to any third party for any modification, suspension, or discontinuance of our presence on or Content posted to the CASCW Video Wall.

# **Privacy Policy**

### **Scope of Privacy Policy**

This policy applies to your use of this Site and all services owned or operated by the Center for Advanced Studies in Child Welfare and any other site that we may own or operate currently or in the future (collectively, the "Sites"). Unless we say otherwise, all references to the Sites in this policy include all such sites. This policy does not apply to your use of unaffiliated sites to which any of the Sites only link. This policy covers only information collected on the Sites and does not cover any information collected offline by us.

### **Personal Identification Information**

We may request personal identification information from you (such as your last name, age, city and state) in connection with your use of, or participation in registration for surveys, forums, content submissions, chats, bulletin boards, discussion groups, requests for suggestions, or additional information, and in connection with other activities, services or resources we make available on any of our Sites. In all of these cases, we will collect personal identification information from you only if you voluntarily submit such information to us. Except as otherwise provided in this policy, we reasonably endeavor to ensure that we never intentionally disclose any personal identification information about you as an individual user to any third party without having received your permission (through opt-in or similar procedures) except as provided for herein or otherwise as permitted or required under law. Further, the Center for Advanced Studies in Child Welfare may contact you based on the information you provide online whether in connection with your registration or in such places as the above described forums.



If you do provide us with personal information for any of these activities, we may use it to conduct the activity.

### **Privacy of Children**

We are mindful that young people need special safeguards and privacy protection. We realize that they may not understand all the provisions of our policy or be able to make thoughtful decisions about the choices that are made available to our adult users. We strongly urge all parents to participate in their children's exploration of the Internet and any online services, and to teach their children about protecting their personal information while online.

#### **Links to Other Sites**

Users will find other content on our Sites that link to the sites and services of our partners, sponsors and other third parties. We do not control the content or links that appear on these sites. In addition, these sites or services, including their content and links, may be constantly changing. These sites and services may have their own privacy policies and customer service policies, or no policy (policies) at all. # **Choice/Opt-Out**

If you "opt-in" to receive information from us, you can change your mind later. If at any time you would like to stop receiving such information or opt-out of a feature, you may change your options by contacting Search Institute. You should be aware, however, that it is not always possible to completely remove or modify information in our databases and servers, although we will always make reasonable efforts to do so upon your request, and we are unable to have your information removed from the records of any third party who has been provided with your information in accordance with this policy.

The Sites are operated in the United States. If you are located in the European Union or elsewhere outside of the United States, please be aware that any information you provide to us will be transferred to the United States. By using our Website, participating in any of our services and/or providing us with your information, you consent to this transfer.
