Biography:

Hilary Brown, PhD is an Assistant Professor at the University of Toronto, in the Department of Health & Society and the Dalla Lana School of Public Health. She is also an Adjunct Scientist at Women's College Hospital and ICES. Dr. Brown holds a Tier 2 Canada Research Chair in Disability & Reproductive Health. Her research program examines maternal and child health and mental health across the life course, with a focus on populations with disabilities and chronic illness, health equity, and the social determinants of health.
