Everyone has a story, everyone has a why, or pivotal moment that helped shape who they are and the work they do.



# Student Engagement: The 5 steps to creating a successful learning environment.


#### STEP #1 - Scaffold the learning

Build belief through work and content that is achievable. At the same time students are feeling success you are also building a positive relationship between teacher and student.

You have to create opportunities for success, successful students want to be successful. Often times struggling students don't know how.

#### **Time for Math Class!**

#### STEP # 2 - Differentiation

- Offer students options to choose from in assignments or lesson plans.
- Provide multiple texts and types of learning materials.
- Utilize a variety of personalized learning methods and student assessments.
- Customize teaching to suit multiple forms of intelligence. One size fits all approach does not work.

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#### STEP # 3 - Feedback

- Provide specific and timely feedback.
- POSITIVE REINFORCEMENT
- Continue to use encouraging positive talk that helps a child develop a
  positive self-image and know that learning is for them.

When parents and teachers praise, encourage, and provide positive feedback to students they are developing children that are more confident and more willing to participate in their learning.

#### **Specific Feedback**

"I like the way you write you name"

"I really like how you helped clean up today"

"You put the pencil in the cup, Nice job."

\*\*\*Be excited about students learning and success. Who doesn't want to feel good about themselves?

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#### **STEP # 4 - Accountability**

Keep high expectations

 Set simple rules and routines and present them in an engaging way. Address behaviors and stay on top of issues that may interrupt students learning.

### STEP # 5 - Social & Emotional Learning (SEL)

 SEL - self awareness, self management, social awareness, positive relationships, and decision making skills.

Embed social emotional learning (SEL) into your daily lessons.
